**Business:**

- A. The Borough Council will consider approval of **Ordinance No. 2019-2** which authorizes the Borough of New Morgan to join with other participating municipalities to enter into an intergovernmental agreement to establish the Berks County Uniform Construction Code Board of Appeals in Cooperation with the County of Berks'. This Ordinance has been advertized and published in the Reading Eagle on Monday March 25<sup>th</sup>, 2019 as required by law.
- B. The Borough Council will consider approval of the Intergovernmental Agreement For The Establishment Of The Berks County Uniform Construction Code Board of Appeals. The purpose of the board is to hear and rule on appeals, requests for variances, and requests for extension of time under Act 45 of 1999. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by borough attorney, Michael Setley.
- C. The Borough Council acknowledges the attached proposed  $\frac{3}{4}$  acre paved unloading area for Manheim vehicles. This has been approved by Woodrow and Associates but has asked for better definition of the project. SBLC will be and has installed additional stop signs and will be restriping the parking area as appropriate once the paving is complete in later spring.
